**Mauricio Carrasco** St. John Vianney once had to calm his visiting sister who kept hearing noises in the presbytery. He said, “It is the devil. He cannot hurt you; as for me he torments me in many ways. At times he seizes me by the feet and drags me about the room.” The same devil had been allowed to have his hour when Jesus was seized with swords and clubs (Luke 22:52-53). We can only pray the good Lord doesn’t let the devil do this to us. If we are to follow Christ, however, we will inevitably find ourselves praying with Him: “My God, why have you forsaken me?
