Sacred Heart Advent Retreat – Discernment of Spirits with Father Mauricio Carrasco

St. John Vianney once had to calm his visiting sister who kept hearing noises in the presbytery. He said, "It is the devil. He cannot hurt you; as for me he torments me in many ways. At times he seizes me by the feet and drags me about the room." The same devil had been allowed to have his hour when Jesus was seized with swords and clubs (Luke 22:52-53). We can only pray the good Lord doesn't let the devil do this to us. If we are to follow Christ, however, we will inevitably find ourselves praying with Him: "My God, why have you forsaken me? (Mark 15:34)" It is in those times that the devil can get the best of us. On December 7th, Sacred Heart will have an Advent Retreat on Discernment of Spirits. The goal is to uncover the father of lies (John 8:44), so that even when we feel to be in the grip of his hands, our hearts will be led by the Holy Spirit to trustingly say:
