Attendees will hear from experts from around the country on human trafficking, pornography, how to recognize victims and how to prevent yourself and loved ones from becoming victims. A free breakfast will be served from 7:30 a.m. to 8 a.m.. A free lunch, sponsored by the Knights of Columbus, will also be served. The symposium will be followed by a 5 p.m. Mass. Parish New Year's Resolutions while at Church

- 1) **Genuflecting:** Giving a genuflection of the right knee—or a profound bow for those physically unable—to the Blessed Sacrament in the tabernacle before sitting in the pew and at the end of mass before leaving the pew.
- 2) **Restrooms:** Except for real emergencies, those with medical conditions, or those with small children, striving to use the restrooms before or after mass and avoiding using them during mass.
- 3) **Punctuality:** Arriving before Mass—this is especially true for the 10:30 mass, where nearly 1/4 or 1/3 of the congregation arrives each week after it has already started. Arriving early allows time for the restroom, prayer, etc. to prepare before Mass starts.
- 4) **Talking in the nave:** At the end of mass, out of respect for the Blessed Sacrament, avoiding visiting with other parishioners in the main church space and waiting until the vestibule to visit.

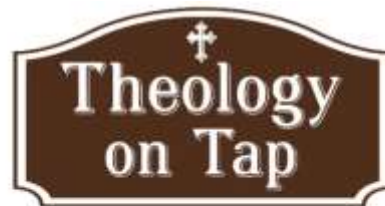
