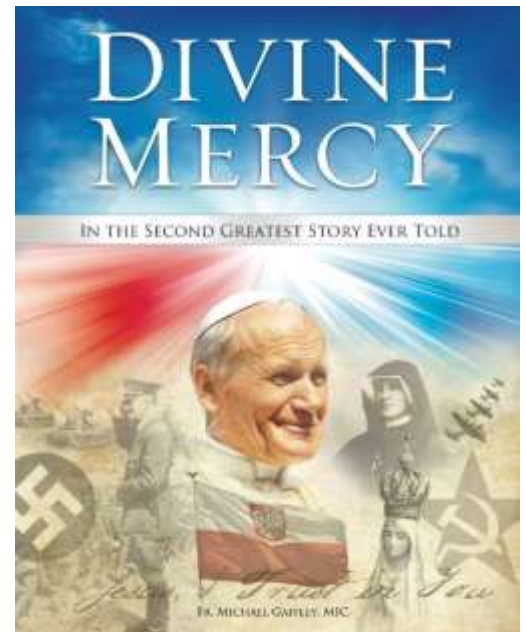
Praise and Worship Service: Meets 1st & 3rd Thursday monthly at 10 a.m. at the Family Mission

From Fr. Stephen: "St. Elizabeth will have a **town hall meeting in the parish hall** to provide details and solicit feedback on possibly constructing an awning over the main north entrance. The parish council has been considering the questions since September and has provided its feedback, but I would like to solicit input from all parishioners. The meeting will Wednesday, **February 5th at 6 p.m.** to allow more time for consideration and to get the word out."

Theology on Tap will be Sunday, January 26th from 4-6 p.m. at Point Remove on the 1st floor. Father Jeffrey Hebert, vocations director for our diocese, will speak with us about "Building a Culture of Vocations" in our homes and parishes.

The Mass of the Presentation of the Lord on **Sunday, February 2nd, will begin around 10:25** in the vestibule with the lighting, blessing, and procession of candles. Each household will be given one take-home candle by ushers, but they are also welcome to bring their own candles to be blessed.

Divine Mercy Lenten Retreat: "Where sin abounds, grace abounds even more." (Romans 5:20). During this upcoming Lenten season, Sacred Heart will be offering **Divine Mercy in the 2nd Greatest Story Ever Told**, a video series that tells the story of Divine Mercy, weaving a thread through Church history that shows God's desire for us to trust in Him and seek His Mercy. The story explores the roles of great saints including St. Faustina, St. Maximilian Kolbe, and Pope St. John Paul II as well as the impact of Fatima and Marian Consecration. Through this study, we will come to understand the Lord's message to us that **"now is the time for mercy."** **Dates/Times:** Seven weekly sessions will be conducted on Sundays beginning February 23 and continuing through April 13. 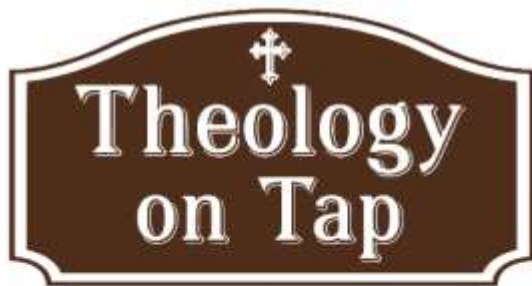
