


Praise and Worship Service: Meets 1st & 3rd Thursday monthly at 10 a.m. at the Family Mission


Divine Mercy Lenten Retreat: "Where sin abounds, grace abounds even more." (Romans 5:20). During this upcoming Lenten season, Sacred Heart will be offering **Divine Mercy in** the 2nd Greatest Story Ever Told, a video series that tells the story of Divine Mercy, weaving a thread through Church history that shows God's desire for us to trust in Him and seek His Mercy. The story explores the roles of great saints including St. Faustina, St. Maximilian Kolbe, and Pope St. John Paul II as well as the impact of Fatima and Marian Consecration. Through this study, we will come to understand the Lord's message to us that "now is the time for mercy." 







