

Lent begins on Ash Wednesday, March 5th. Masses will be at 7 am, 9 am (school), and 6:30 p.m. (PRE) While a solemn day, Ash Wednesday is not a holy day of obligation.

- For Catholics <u>14 and over</u>, Ash Wednesday is a day of <u>abstinence</u>, which is defined as refraining from eating the flesh meat of mammals and fowl.
- For Catholics <u>18-59</u>, Ash Wednesday is also a day of <u>fasting</u>, which is defined as one normal size meal in the course of the day plus two smaller sized meals that, when added together, are still less than the normal meal.
- Those who are ill or pregnant are not obligated to fast, but they are still to observe abstinence.

All <u>Fridays</u> of Lent are also days of abstinence for those 14 and over.

Stations of the Cross will be held each Friday of Lent at 6 p.m.



# Calling all Sacred Heart Parishioners- help us Restore the Bells!

We have some exciting news to share with you! Until recently, Sacred Heart's bells have been ringing on the Sacred Heart Campus for over 100 years! The bells hold a treasured history and while relocated to the newly constructed bell tower in 1983, our bells and bell tower need essential maintenance, and they need YOUR help!

Additionally, as part of a broader effort to improve your mass experience, we are planning other sound improvements within the sacristy to create a balanced and comfortable auditory environment, ensuring that the sound doesn't become too overwhelming or distorted. Like many churches, we have unique acoustic challenges due to the size and hard surfaces present within our church. Auditory improvements to include professional sound balancing of audio equipment; including cry room and vestibule, purchase of microphones, and evaluation for installation of sound dampening options. To make this vision a reality, our goal is to raise \$27,025.00, which is the market cost of the repairs.

Auditory Improvements Church and Sacristy \$3,500.00
Project Contingency (15%) \$3,525.00
