Holy day on December 9th. You may remember how for many years here in the US, certain solemnities like the Assumption (August 15th) or All Saints (November 1st) that fell on a Saturday or Monday would not be a holy day of obligation for that year. Earlier this month, however, the Vatican clarified to the US bishops that this would no longer be the case. Henceforth, every holy day of obligation, no matter what day of the week, will remain a holy day of obligation. This applies even to transferred holy days, like when the Immaculate Conception (December 8th) falls on a Sunday of Advent and is moved to Monday the 9th, as is the case this year. As such, <u>Monday, December 9th, solemnity of the Immaculate Conception, will be a holy day of obligation this year</u>. I realize that this may prove inconvenient for the faithful, especially in the near term, but I hope that it will be more beneficial spiritually for us all in the long run: 1) there will be no more guessing if something is a holy day of obligation from one year to the next 2) it will ensure that the faithful celebrate these important days each year. ~ Fr.
